Film Festival: Pearls from 3 Decades of Molloy College Film Festivals: *A Man for All Seasons*

As finale of the 2004-05 series, "Pearls from 3 Decades of Molloy College Film Festivals," Molloy is delighted to present *A Man for All Seasons* 7:30 p.m., Friday, February 18, in the Lucille S. Hays Theatre of the Wilbur Arts Center on the Molloy campus.

In this film adaptation of his great play, Robert Bolt has honed to even greater artistic achievement his depiction of a saint for all ages: his "hero of selfhood." Supported by a superb cast, Paul Schofield renders the finest performance of his career as Thomas More, that essentially good man, warmly human, clinging tenaciously to life, yet utterly true to his personal convictions, to his faith, to his God.

Joining festival coordinator Sister Mary Verity McNicholas for the post-film discussion will be Rev. Msgr. James P. Lisante, pastor of St. Thomas the Apostle, West Hempstead, whose enthusiasm for film features significantly in his ministry through lecturing and writing.

After his presentation, Monsignor Lisante will join festival coordinator Sister Mary Verity, O.P., Ph.D., for the audience-involved discussion of further ramifications of the film.

Sister Mary Verity, professor emerita of film and drama criticism at Molloy, served as film critic and consultant for the U.S. Catholic Conference until the relocation of its headquarters to Washington, D.C.
