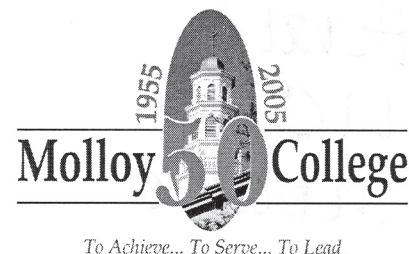

The Siena Women's Center at Molloy College will be presenting its 9th annual Academic Symposium on April 22nd from 9:30 am until 4:00 pm in the Hays Theatre in the Wilbur Arts Center. This event is open to the public.

Molloy College President Drew Bogner will open the academic symposium which is the kick-off to Molloy's year-long 50th anniversary celebration. The day's agenda includes Sister Margaret Ormond, O.P., Director, Dominican Sisters International, speaking about "Dominican Tradition Moving into the Future." Suzanne Noffke, O.P., Scholar in Residence, University of Wisconsin, Parkside, will give a talk entitled, "Praising, Blessing, Preaching: Saint Catherine Throws Down the Gauntlet." Timothy Radcliffe, O.P., Former Master of the Dominican Order, will discuss contemporary church issues during his talk entitled, "A House Divided: A Dominican Contribution Towards Healing the Wounds of the Church." A panel and audience discussion will follow.
