Molloy College and its Writer-in-Residence, Barbara Novack, will be hosting "A Special Afternoon with Kate Light" on Sunday, October 22, 2006 at 3:00 p.m. in the Multipurpose Room in the Wilbur Arts Center on the Molloy College campus. This event is free and open to the public.

Kate Light is renowned for her lively readings. Her most recent book, *Gravity's Dream: New Poems and Sonnets*, won the Donald Justice Award. In addition to her poetry collections, she has written text and poetry for the concert pieces *Oceanaphony* (available on CD), which she has narrated with orchestras, and *Einstein's Mozart: Two Geniuses*, as well as lyrics for Disney's *Mulan II*. Her work has also appeared in journals and anthologies, and she has been featured several times on Garrison Keillor's *Writer's Almanac*. She is also a professional violinist in New York City. An open reading will follow Ms. Light's poetry reading.

The Poetry Events at Molloy College series was founded by Barbara Novack, Writer-in-Residence at Molloy College, in conjunction with the English Department. The aim of the series is to bring contemporary poetry to a wider audience.
