**Molloy College Art Gallery Presents  
Peter Marcus -- The Horsehead Series**

The Molloy College Art Gallery will present the work of printmaker Peter Marcus from November 10 through December 21<sup>st</sup>, 2006.

Mr. Marcus' large scale architectural collagraphs explores several turn-of-the-century buildings in Jamestown, Rhode Island and St. Louis, Missouri, and the relation of these to Piranesi and Meryon. A catalogue accompanies the exhibition with an essay by Francesca Herdon-Consagra, Curator of Prints, Drawings and Photographs at the St. Louis Art Museum.

"In this series, Marcus seduces the viewer with the beautiful interplay of marks and space then leaves the viewer to imagine entering the building. The scale is so large that it invites the viewer in," states Dr. Herdon-Consagra.

Mr. Marcus will give a lecture on Friday, November 10, 2006 at 1:00p.m. in the Wilbur Arts building on the Molloy College campus. This lecture is open to the public. There will also be an opening reception for the artist from 4:00 -6:00 p.m.
