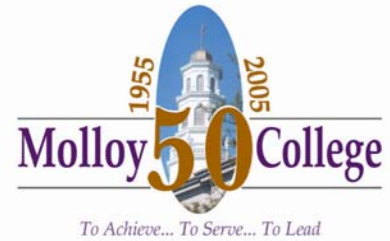

The Molloy College Center for Christian/Jewish Studies invites the community to attend a lecture regarding the Holocaust on April 23, 2006 at 3:00 pm, in the Anselma Room, Kellenberg Hall at Molloy College. This event is free and open to the public.

During the Holocaust, parents gave their children to neighbors or friends who were not Jewish, with the hope that their children might survive. The families who took these children did so with incredible courage because of the danger that would result if they were discovered. Some of the "Hidden Children" who survived will tell their life stories.
