Molloy College Hosts Summer Nursing Exploration Camp: Engaging Future Generations in Nursing

In an effort to inspire future nurses and also engage students in the sciences, Molloy College, Mercy Medical Center and South Nassau Communities Hospital will open their campuses to Baldwin and Oceanside middle school students, providing them with insight and instruction into the nursing profession. The program, in its fourth year, is designed to help students have a better understanding and appreciation for the nursing profession, and to hopefully be inspired to pursue a career in this field.

The camp begins on Monday, June 26 and runs until Friday, June 30.
