**Molloy College Art Exhibit**  
**Don Resnick: "A Brush with Nature"**

The Molloy College Art Gallery will exhibit the work of Rockville Centre painter, Don Resnick from September 13th through October 26th, 2007. Mr. Resnick is an internationally-known artist who is represented by galleries both in New York City and Toronto, Canada. There will be a reception on Thursday September 13<sup>th</sup> from 4-7 pm for the artist. The community is invited to attend.

"A Brush with Nature" is composed of large-scale paintings of landscapes throughout New England that Mr. Resnick created during the last few years. There will also be several watercolors included in the exhibition.

Phyllis Braff, former New York Times art critic commented on Mr. Resnick's work: "The heightened color effects of Resnick and his light-filled Long Island scenes are joyfully colored and vibrantly brushed and give the appearance of celebrating nature. One has to think, even briefly, of Impressionism reinterpreted. Mr. Resnick's use of arbitrary colors is boldly handled in the foreground."

Don Resnick has exhibited at the Odon Wagner Gallery in Toronto, Hobart College, and Elaine Benson Gallery in Bridgehampton, New York among numerous galleries, museums and universities across the country. His work is in the collections of the Portland Museum of Art, Williams College of Art, Emerson Gallery and the National Museum of American Art at the Smithsonian Institution in Washington, D.C.
