Colette G. Mazzucelli, Ph.D, Assistant Professor, Department of History and Political Science, Molloy College, was awarded a Fulbright Scholar grant which enabled her to participate in the German Studies Seminar, "*Germany in a Changing Europe Transatlantic Ties, Transatlantic Challenges,*" at the German-American Fulbright Commission in Berlin, Germany during summer 2007.
