Molloy College Appoints New Dean of Nursing

Jeannine D. Muldoon, Ph.D. has been appointed Dean of the Division of Nursing at Molloy College. Dr. Muldoon completed her undergraduate studies at Boston College School of Nursing. She earned a Master of Science at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst, in the Graduate Program in Community Health Nursing with a specialty in Family Nurse Practice. She then continued her studies at the University of Massachusetts, School of Public Health and received a Ph.D. with a major concentration in Health Policy and Management.

Prior to coming to Molloy College in 2006, Dr. Muldoon held the rank of professor. Additionally, she held several administrative positions including Director of the Undergraduate Nursing Program at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst and Chairperson of the Nursing Program at Elms College. She was Dean of the School of Nursing and Health Systems at SUNY Institute of Technology at Utica/Rome, and Founding Dean of the School of Nursing at Massachusetts College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences. She has authored and co-authored an impressive number of journal articles and served on various Boards of Directors and Advisory Boards in Massachusetts, New York, and Maryland.

Additionally, she has served as a Consultant on Nursing and public health issues and as a Site Evaluator for the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education, the accreditation arm of the American Association of Colleges of Nursing. During her time at Molloy, Dr. Muldoon has served as Director of the Graduate Nursing Program and co-chaired the committee responsible for the new undergraduate Nursing curriculum which will be in effect in the Fall 2008 semester.
