Author James Howard Kunstler Speaks at Molloy College

James Howard Kunstler, author of the controversial books, *The Geography of Nowhere*, and *The Long Emergency*, will present his views at Molloy College on Thursday, November 13, 2008 at 2:00 p.m. The lecture will be held in the Hays Theatre, Wilbur Arts Center, on Molloy's Rockville Centre campus. All are invited to attend this discussion about America's unyielding dependency on oil and its impact on the future of suburban America.

Mr. Kunstler predicts that America's continued dependency on oil will significantly and negatively impact the lifestyle of future generations.
